

FUNNY FARM GAME BOARD HOW-TO

MATERIALS:

8 x 10 (or so) unfinished wooden frame

4 x 6 image from Funny Farm

2mm [white foam sheet](#)

Self adhesive [black foam sheet](#)

[Foam music stickers](#)

Thin black sharpie

Craft glue

Scissors

Ruler

Calculator

PLEASE NOTE:

Because not all frames are alike, I decided not to include specific measurements. This will allow for more flexibility on your part. Use what works!

DIRECTIONS:

- 1) Print the 4x6 Funny Farm picture and cut it out, leaving enough white border so that it will fit perfectly in your frame. Insert it into the picture frame.
- 2) Measure the areas for the keyboards to the left and right of the center. (Mine were 4.5" x 2 — yours may be different depending on your frame.) Cut white foam to fit those two areas. Measure the white foam parts into 4 equally sized “keys” and mark them with the thin sharpie and a ruler.
- 3) Repeat this process for the keyboards above and below the center. These keyboards will need seven equally spaced keys—get out your ruler AND your calculator!
- 4) Glue the keyboards down on the frame as shown in the picture. This will leave four corners that need to be covered. Using the black foam, measure four squares to fill in those areas. Cut them out and stick them to the board.
- 5) Cut black keys to size for your keyboards. You will need 16 total. Stick them to the keyboards as shown.
- 6) Decorate the black squares with musical foam stickers. Your board is complete!
